Bath Foodbank: We've had an urgent appeal from Bath Foodbank for more donations. Referrals to the foodbank have increased by 13% since last year,



with about 50 new households each month accessing food support for the first time. We hope to make a brown-bag collection at HT in a few weeks, but in the meantime the following urgently-needed items can be donated at dropoff points in supermarkets,
