Prayer meeting at StACC

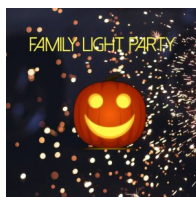
A monthly prayer meeting is restarting at St Andrews, on the third Tuesday of each month. Next meeting: 18 October, 7.30pm
