Amen

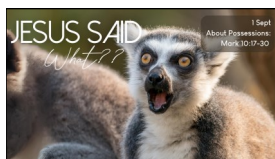

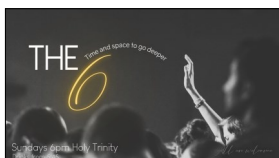

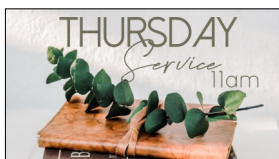

Harvest Hog Roast

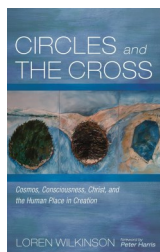
