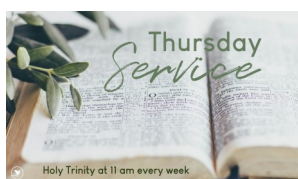

- 7.30pm – 8.30pm The prayer meeting for revival this evening will take place online. Please contact Victoria Strang for the link.

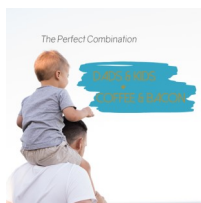
Sunday 11 June
