through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen



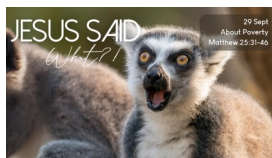

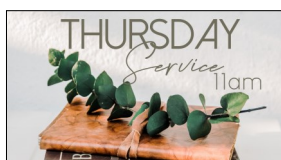

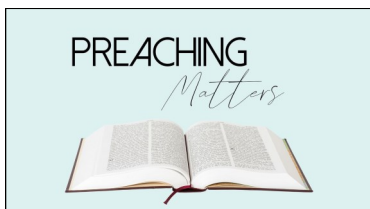
