Amen



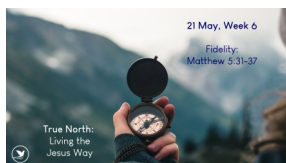

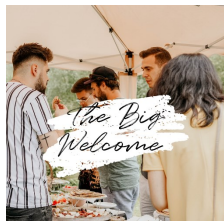
