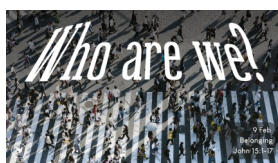
Lord of the hosts of heaven,

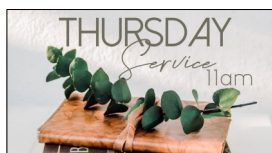

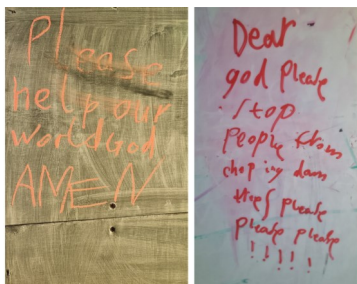
