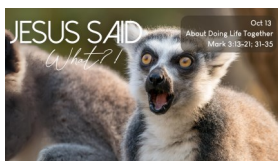

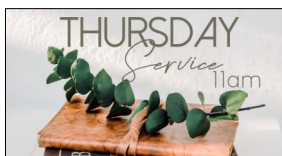

The Flourish Project has begun in Combe Down School.

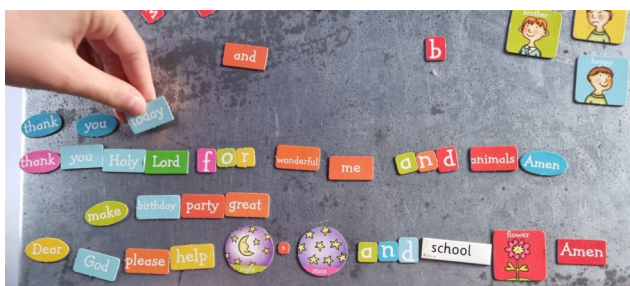
