

Sunday 22 October 2023 Sermon Series Facing Evil: Habakkuk Living By Faith

Here are the home group questions for Habakkuk 2:1-4

- Warm up I light heartedly mentioned 2 music tracks to illustrate the talk. What music would you choose and why?
- Read Habakkuk 2:1-4
- How does the image of 'standing at your watch and stationing yourself on the ramparts' work for you? What does it make you think of? Is it helpful or not?
- What do you go up on the ramparts for? What are you watching and waiting for?
- What does this mean in practice?
- How do you manage to keep going in this? What sustains you? If like me you get distracted, how do you get back on watch? When it takes a long time, how do you keep going?
- Look up the references to 'the righteous will live by faith' in the New Testament (Romans 1:17; Galatians 3.11; Hebrews 10:37–38). How to the NT writers apply this old phrase?
- I didn't talk about verses 2&3, but you may like to think about those too. Why write this down? What does this remind us of? Why would a herald run with it?
- What practically might you do in response to these 4 verses, and the challenge to us to take up our watch?
- Pray for one another.
