- Physically able to carry out manual handling and occasional work at height.
- Reliable, punctual, and conscientious approach to duties.

Personal Qualities

- Trustworthy and able to maintain confidentiality.
- Friendly, approachable, and professional manner.
- Flexible and adaptable to meet the needs of the church's worship and community life.
- Committed to maintaining high standards of cleanliness and presentation.
- Supportive of the Christian ethos and mission of Combe Down PCC.

Other Requirements

- Willingness to work (very) occasional evenings and weekends as required.
- Full UK driving licence and ability to travel between sites.

Desirable Criteria

Experience and Knowledge

- Previous experience in a caretaking role.
- Experience supervising contractors or managing maintenance schedules.
- Familiarity with statutory compliance checks (e.g. PAT testing, boiler servicing, fire safety logs).

- First Aid qualification (or willingness to undertake training).
- Health and Safety or maintenance-related training or certification.
