Philippians 2:2-4 and 19-30

Paul gives the Philippian church some instruction on humility in v2-4.

1. Who does he use as the primary example to help the church to live like this?
2. Why does he use this person as his first example?

Paul then describes the attributes of his friend Timothy to the Philippian church to explain how they serve well together.

3. How can you tell Paul considers Timothy:
 - a. Trustworthy v19?
 - b. Like-minded v20?
 - c. Selfless v20-21
 - d. Mature in faith v22?
4. As part of the body of the church, how do we develop these attributes/qualities?

Paul described Epaphroditus as his “brother, fellow-worker and fellow soldier”.

5. “There is no hierarchy in the kingdom” – what does this mean and how does it/does it work in practice?
6. What does it look like to be a ‘fellow-worker’ at htcd?
7. What/who are we fighting and how are we to be ‘fellow-soldiers’ at htcd?
